THE e-COURSE

Scope

The e-course, which is intended for those responsible for the certification of ships, will cover all relevant IMO safety and pollution prevention conventions, procedures and mechanisms involved in the issuance of the certificates, associated surveys, and items to be surveyed and the acceptance criteria.

It will also highlight the requirements for setting up an effective maritime safety administration and its task in getting conventions adopted, ratified and enforced. It will detail the procedures needed to give effect to all related recommendations and codes and the need for, as well as the role of, the Competent Authorities.

The e-course also deals with the role of recognized organizations and how these can be authorized to act on behalf of the maritime administration.

Included in the e-course coverage are the administration's duties and responsibilities with respect to investigation into marine accidents and incidents.

Objectives

Those who successfully complete the e-course will be able to carry out effectively the duties imposed upon a Maritime Administration as a result of opening a ship's registry; the ratification of IMO safety and pollution prevention conventions and flag State duties consequential to these actions. They will be able to initiate action to prepare appropriate legislation, issue shipping notices, initiate relevant investigations and follow up reports from other Maritime Administrations with respect to ships under their flag.

Entry Standards

The e-course is open to officials from maritime administrations and port authorities who have responsibility in the investigations of marine accidents or who may be planning to undertake such responsibilities.

A good knowledge of English language is needed.

NOTE: Attendants must provide for the following equipment requirements:

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- Internet access with a good grade of connection.
- Access to a computer or laptop with related facilities (working microphone and camera).

Modules and certificate

Upon successful completion of the e-course, trainees will be issued a certificate of attendance, signed by IMO and IMSSEA, attesting to their participation. It will be send by courier after the completion of the distant learning course.

The attendance of the participants will be registered by IMSSEA Staff and Lecturers by means of tests to get over after each module as a follow-up and proof of keeping up with the course sessions.

e-CLASS ACTIVITIES

The e-course will be delivered throughout the **IMSSEA Moodle E-learning platform** directly available from the IMSSEA website at this link <https://imssea.org/poseidon>

FSI e-course will be held from **24 November** to **4 December 2020**; each lesson, divided into modules, generally lasts from 15' to 40', according to the development and the completion of all the topics related to the IMO Model course.

Live events are also envisaged all along the period of the delivery of the course with a provisional scheme as the following one:

- **one live event** at the beginning of the e-course for the opening of the online edition, coordinated by IMSSEA Staff. This wants to be a very moment devoted to the introduction of all the participants and the Academy staff describing the structure of the course programme and showing the lecturers trainees will "meet" during the days of e-training.
- **Two/three live events** with the lecturers for direct debates, review of topics, exercises, exchange of views. This will be a very important occasion for attendees to deepen issues dealt with during the e-learning individual sessions.
- **One live event** at the end of the e-course for final activities, evaluation questionnaire and greetings.

The programme of live moments will be available on the platform at the related section of the specific course.

The dates and times of live events will be defined accordingly with the time zone of all the attendees and for this reason they could be planned more than only one session.



Evaluation form for lecturers

Participants will be individually evaluated on the basis of participation, attitude and skill tests. Lecturers will complete an evaluation form for each attendee at the end of their module.

Evaluation form for attendees

An evaluation form for participants to evaluate modules and lecturers will be provided during the e-course. The purpose of this form is to give constructive feedback to the Academy about the e-lesson observed and how the lecturer positively impacted the attendee's e-learning.

Final questionnaire

At the end of the course participants will be asked for filling a questionnaire in order to collect the views on the e-course. Impression, criticism and suggestion will help the Academy to improve the standards of this modality of training.
